The Role of an Urban Driver - Urban drivers are at the heart of the supply chain. They operate in diverse business sectors that rely on timely, reliable deliveries and collections, including retail, removals, construction, pallet distribution, laundry, recycling, agriculture, and manufacturing.

Geographically located and operating to time-critical schedules, urban drivers keep businesses moving. They typically drive fixed-axle vehicles over 3,500kg, completing multi-drop routes in congested areas while delivering specialist services and technical support alongside the goods they transport.

- Specialist on-site support including product handling, installation, or technical advice

On completion of this programme, you will be able to:

- Fuel, Prepare and monitor the urban vehicle.
- Operate machinery, tools and protective equipment designed to correctly load and unload goods.
- Work with team members to support business needs across a designated urban area.
- Drive a 3500KG fixed axle Vehicle, delivering & collecting goods between short-haul urban locations.
- Keeping customers informed of progress against plans.
- Contribute to environmental & Sustainability objectives as well as upholding corporate values.
- Consider the needs of vulnerable road users and other stakeholders.
- Manage changing volumes of load throughout the urban delivery cycle.
- Be able to manoeuvre the vehicle into position, typically into space is at a premium.
- Risk assessment of the site and planned activities, adjusting operations as required.
- Work compliantly at all times, with regards to driving regulations, site specific requirements, company policies, and health & safety.
- Completes any additional contracted services, using the correct equipment, this includes assembly, installation, packing and positioning of loads.
- Complete all required reporting procedures e.g. digital and paper based.
- Follows continuous professional development, maintaining own drivers licence and ensuring required training and knowledge is kept up to date e.g. drivers CPC needs to be renewed ever 5 years with 35 hours of training.
